PFAS

We, and our products, follow to the best of our knowledge the REACH legislation (EG 1907/2006) and the PFAS substances included there.

CEJN AB acknowledge and agree that PFAS is a big problem for a sustainable future. Therefore, we are closely following the work with a legislation restricting 10⁶ of thousands of PFAS within the European Union. We are participating in the ongoing discussion through European Chemical Agency (ECHA).

Meanwhile we have decided to include PFAS in our constantly ongoing communication with our suppliers about chemical content in our material and chemicals. Having a good knowledge about where we have PFAS makes us prepared and opens the possibility to act before legislation is in force.

Our aim is to have knowledge of all direct and indirect material and chemicals that includes PFAS both inhouse and at our suppliers. We believe this will make us stronger going forward on this important subject.

What is PFAS?

PFAS, Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances, is a large and complex group of over 10 000 identified substances with varying properties. One thing that all PFAS have in common is that they are very difficult to break down. Some PFAS are harmful to both the environment and human health. All PFAS are man-made synthetics that do not occur naturally in the environment. You can find more information here:
